1. The online application for **KansasBio** Local BioGENEius Challenge will be coming soon. Please check back in October. **Submissions must be completed on the Biotechnology Institute site by February 18, 2011.**
2. If you are selected as one of the three (3) local finalists, you are eligible to **receive up to a \$400 reimbursement** and an invitation to compete in the **U.S. National BioGENEius Challenge.**

KansasBio Local BioGENEius Challenge Information

KansasBio Local BioGENEius Challenge will occur in three phases:

1. The first phase will include a special award for up to three Kansas BioGENEius Finalists as a Special Award at the Kansas City Science and Engineering Fair (an ISEF fair) March 23-26, 2011.
2. The second phase will include a special award for up to three Kansas BioGENEius Finalists as a Special Award at the Kansas State Science and Engineering Fair (an ISEF fair) April 1-2, 2011.
3. The third phase will include oral and poster presentations for up to six finalists in April 2011. Up to three winners will be awarded and an alternate for eligibility to compete in the U.S. National BioGENEius Challenge, Washington, D.C. in June.
