



Legislative BioBuzz: Week of February 22 – 26, 2010

Coming this Week:

Angel Investor Tax Credit Amendment

On Wednesday March 3rd, the House Tax Committee will hear HB 2496, a bill dealing with restoring the historic preservation tax credit included in last year's budget bill (which also cut the angel investor tax credit as well). Ron Seeber approached the Committee Chair and bill's author informing them of our intention to amend the bill allowing existing angel investor credit to carry forward. Representative Marvin Kleeb has agreed to carry our amendment and Kansas Department of Revenue will not oppose. Unfortunately, the Department says the amendment will have a fiscal note of over \$825,000 which will make our pitch more difficult. Recent revenue estimates show that the state is \$70 million more in the hole than previously thought. Angela Kreps, Public Policy Chair Kevin Sweeney, and KTEC CEO Kevin Carr will testify explaining that the credits are privately held property and that credits restoration is needed to ensure investor confidence.

Week in Review:

This week started slowly with the legislature taking Monday off after turnaround, but quickly gained momentum. After lengthy debate, the House approved and sent to the Governor a bill that bans smoking in most public locations. Certain exemptions apply including private clubs, smoke shops, nursing homes and state owned and operated casinos.

KTEC Funding Restored

The House Appropriations Committee heard a recommendation from the House Agriculture Budget Committee that cuts \$500k from Kansas Technology Enterprise Corporation (KTEC) and directing the money to the Missouri River Association of States and Tribes (MoRAST) regional interstate organization fund (\$62500), Kansas Department of Agriculture's Ag statistics program (\$20,000), KDA's Grain Warehouse Program (\$75k), KDA's Dairy Inspection Program (\$72k) and the Attorney General's Water Litigation Fund (\$326,750). KTEC Board member Representative Doug Gatewood made a motion to restore the \$500k back to KTEC and deny the subcommittee's recommendation. The motion was approved.

American Royal Becoming Anti-GMO?

According to a recent [Kansas City Star Article](#), the American Royal has decided to promote a food event that is focusing on food that is hormone free and antibiotic free. This sends a message the genetically modified food is less healthy than hormone and antibiotic free. A letter has been sent to the American Royal with a number of agriculture related voicing concerns.

Ethanol Blending Bill

After full Senate approved [SB 425](#), the bill requiring terminals to offer all grades of fuel in Kansas, the Speaker of the House received the bill from the Senate and referred the bill to the House Commerce Committee. Kansas Association of Ethanol Processors and the Petroleum Marketers support this bill because it will allow for more blended fuels at the pump.

Rainy Day Fund

The Senate Ways and Means Committee held a hearing on SCR 1627. This an amendment to the Kansas Constitution creating a budget stabilization fund. It would require that 1% of state revenue be placed into a "rainy day" fund. The fund would be capped at 7.5% of total annual revenue. The legislature would vote to transfer funds from the fund to the state general fund only when there is a budget deficit and that the deficit not be caused a tax cut. State Treasurer Dennis McKinney testified in support, but suggested the limit be raised to 15%. The Kansas Chamber also testified in support and suggested a spending stipulation, in addition to the tax cut provision, be placed on the amendment as well.
